The return of students to classrooms also marks a return to homework. Students will once again fill their late afternoon and evening hours in search of answers to math and science questions, puzzling over syntax and researching for papers.

The program is known as HomeworkKansas: a live, interactive computer-generated tutoring service providing homework help in math, science, English and social studies. The service is available 7-days a week from 4 p.m. to 11 p.m. For most subjects, tutors can also provide assistance in Spanish.
